



COLLECTIONS ALL THROUGHOUT THE YEAR!

Box Tops for Education® has very specific ways that schools must put together their submissions. The company will only accept submissions that are packaged in 50 single Box Tops together in the following ways:

- 1) Collection sheets must have a maximum of 10 single pink Box Tops only glued or taped to each piece of paper. We then put 5 of these sheets together to make the 50 that are required. It's okay for students to turn in sheets that aren't complete because we always have loose ones that we use to complete the sheet of 10.
- 2) Single Box Tops can be put together in groups of 50 either by using a rubber band or placed in a zippered (or small sandwich) plastic bag. Families send in single Box Tops and our volunteers count and package them up.

Bonus box tops (either the white slips of paper, cardboard strips or coupons from plastic bags) need to be submitted separately and cannot be on collection sheets. These are bound by the amounts, counted and packaged apart from the single pink Box Tops. Samples are below.

This is the only way to submit the Box Tops to the company and we're trying to save everyone's time in making this project a success. Here are some additional things to remember:

- Clipping directly on the dotted lines helps our volunteers immensely!
- Expired Box Tops cannot be submitted. We all agree that the date on Box Tops are sometimes very hard to read, but we've been sorting through them and discarding any that cannot be counted as money for our school.
- Check area grocery store sale flyers for chances to enter drawings for Lake Street School to win thousands of Box Tops. These forms usually need to be mailed in and are specifically for that week only.
- Box Tops are sold on Ebay if someone is interested in making the donation to buy them, but watch those dates!
- Go to the Box Tops website: www.btfe.com or www.boxstops4education.com where you can keep up with how much Lake Street School is earning, enter online promotions for chances to win Bonus Box Tops and other prizes, in addition to printing coupons for items that provide Box Tops.

What are Labels for Education?

They are barcodes with the "Labels for Education" logo or wording next to it and many samples are pictured below. Only the barcode with the logo that's trimmed on the dotted line should be submitted; not the entire product label.

These too need to be separated by point value, but do not need to be batched in a certain way for our submission. We submit these in paper bags or envelopes, so everything can be recycled (much better on the environment!) and there is no deadline.

Campbell's has "e-labels for education." Go to the Labels for Education website: www.labelsforeducation.com and after registering your Price Chopper and/or ShopRite store savings card number, every time you buy a participating product, Lake Street School automatically gets a point. This is in addition to still clipping the points on products for us to mail in.
